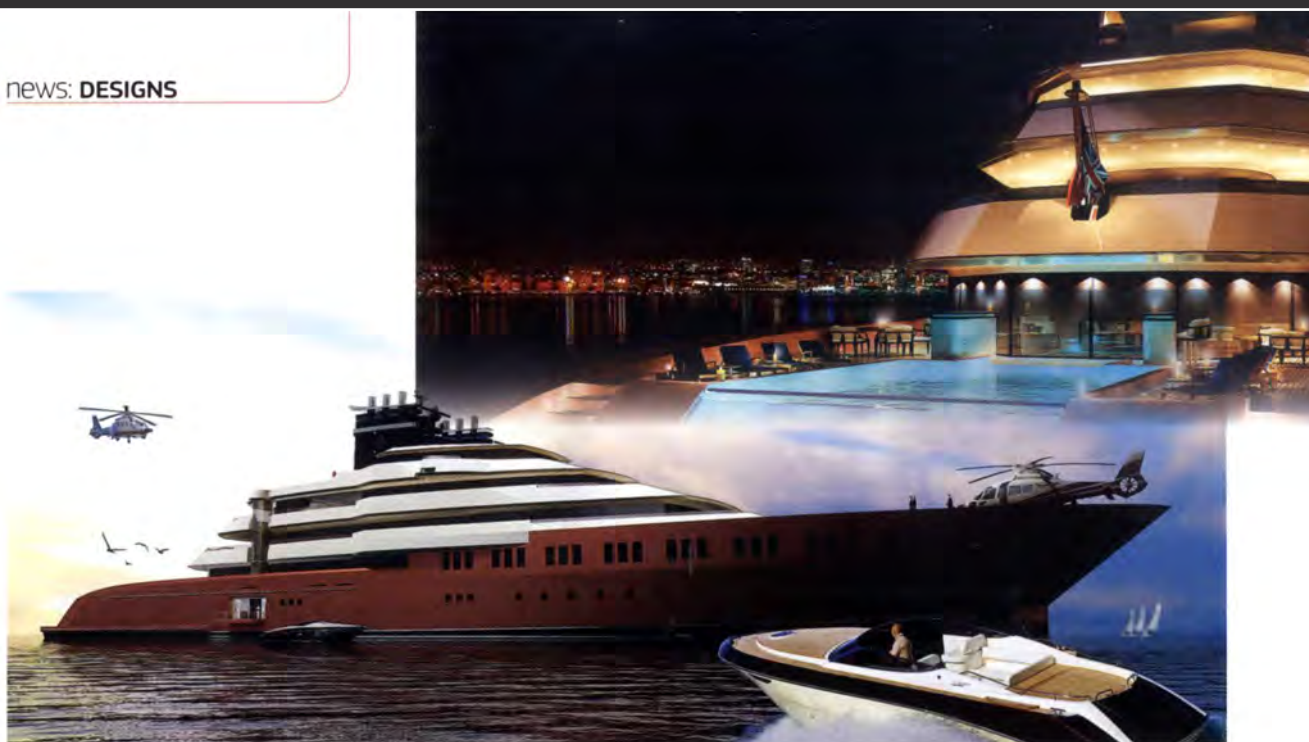

394-FOOT OCEANCO

THE NETHERLANDS' FUTURE LARGEST YACHT

OCEANCO CURRENTLY HOLDS THE RECORD for the largest yacht to come from a Dutch yard with the 312-foot *Indian Empress* (ex-*Al Mirqab*), but this might be topped by a new design for the yard by Nuvolari-Lenard. The Italian design team was called upon to develop the 394-foot platform and exterior styling. Oceanco and Nuvolari-Lenard previously have collaborated on four yachts, including 267-foot *Alfa Nero* and 282-foot *Seven Seas*—the Oceanco infinity pool was introduced on the former. “Nuvolari-Lenard was motivated to close a design circle that goes from *Amevi* through *Alfa Nero*, *Vibrant Curiosity* and *Seven Seas* and gets concluded with this large yacht with elements of the last decade of design,” says Dan Nuvolari.

Inspired by military ships, the 394-foot design—among the largest from Nuvolari-Lenard at 1,800 GRT—has strong, powerful lines. According to the design team, they paid close attention to studying the balance between hull length and height as well as the volume and position of the superstructure to create a unique silhouette. Distinctive features include a set of chimneys, VIP cabin balconies, an expansive aft deck, 1,615 square feet of beach club and twin glass elevators that connect the lower deck with the owners' private upper deck. The seven-deck yacht also will include a retractable hangar for a resident helicopter. www.nuvolari-lenard.com
