Oceanco sails Seven Seas New 86m delivered ahead of schedule

Built under the project name Y706, launched as Seven Seas and delivered to her new owners a month ahead of schedule, Oceanco's latest product is a truly stunning yacht. The design, the result of a collaboration between Oceanco, Nuvolari & Lenard, Azure Naval Architects and the Wright Maritime Group, continues the yard's legacy of building award winning yachts like Amevi, Alfa Nero, Anastasia, Vibrant Curiosity, and most recently Sunrays. The owner, rumoured to be Steven Spielberg, had significant input into the interior design; the main salon is equipped with a professional projection system and 5x2m screen which, coupled with two rows of raked seating, will transform into a screening theatre. A further projection screen serves the aft infinity pool, projecting images onto the glass wall. Adjacent to the main salon is an imposing 250sqm area which can host everything from casual al fresco dining to a black-tie gala. Seven Seas, powered by dual 4,680hp/3,492 kW MTU engines can reach speeds up to 20 knots. Having accomplished some sensational builds below 100m, Oceanco is now expanding facilities to break through this barrier to produce their next generation of luxury yachts.
