A Grand Marquis New 42 Sport Bridge model

Adding to their cutting edge range designed by Nuvolari-Lenard, Marquis Yachts announce a new 42' design in January. This new yacht, the Marquis 420 Sport Bridge, incorporates a roomy fly bridge, which should make it popular in the Middle East. A centred helm station enables the owner to install an expansive array of instrumentation including dual 12" touch screen displays and for passengers there is a variety of seating and lounge space. At deck level the new 420 Sport Bridge is designed around the Marquis signature integrated cockpit/salon layout. The swim platform, cockpit, salon and galley utilise a unified, single level floor plan that allows these areas flow together as a single environment for social gathering. Moving the cockpit transom seat and table, fore or aft, at the touch of a button, enhances space. The salon table can also be adjusted to either cocktail or meal height by actuating via electronic control. Power will be delivered by dual Volvo Penta petrol or diesel engines to IPS pod drives.
