PROJECT HERMES | 210 FEET

Designed by Nuvolari-Lenard and built in aluminum, Project Hermes will be overseen by Moran's new construction team, with delivery scheduled for November 2013. The 210-footer will sleep 12 guests in six staterooms and is powered by twin 4,150-hp MTU engines, giving a maximum speed of 28 knots and transatlantic range. Project Hermes offers all the areas of a tri-deck yacht wrapped in the muscular and sleek signature profile of a Palmer Johnson Sports Yacht.

This PJ 210 gives the best of both worlds—huge open and covered deck areas for a relaxed and informal lifestyle that flow into generous salons, a formal dining area and a cinema. The master suite on the main deck has large circular windows as well as a fold-down balcony. Four guest cabins are on the lower deck along with a gym, sea terrace and a sauna.

Swimming pools will be located on both the aft deck and the foredeck. An interesting option is to use the entire main aft deck as a pool/beach club, moving the dining to the upper deck. There is also a private sun deck area for the owner accessible via disappearing stairs in the mast. A helicopter landing area is also available on the foredeck via a clever sliding mechanism for covering the pool.
