Floated at the Hakvoort shipyard in the quaint Dutch town of Monnickendam, 209ft *Scout* is the family-owned company's new flagship. The explorer, complete with helipad, filled every bit of space in the construction shed before being backed into the water on December 1. Still in need of finishing touches, such as mast, radar, crew's nest and underwater appendages, the yacht was then towed to nearby Amsterdam for

final commissioning. Resold by Fraser to a new client in the early stages of construction, the project acquired a new look. The new owners told H2 Yacht Design they wanted their new steel-hulled yacht to have the feel and appearance of a converted commercial vessel. IN THE BIG LEAGUE

Turkish shipyard AvA Yachts has sold a 115ft yacht in its Kando110 series to NBA star Tony Parker.

The series, built in steel and aluminum in Antalya, is an explorer in spirit with a bulbous bow and extended range (in excess of 6,000nm). Contemporary touches include two 650hp Volvo Penta D16 MH engines, a beach club and plenty of glass to brighten the



voluminous interior (it is around 340 gross tonnes). Parker visited the shipyard in person and hired experts to evaluate the project, which was already under construction and listed for sale. His yet-to-be named Kando110 will be the second of the series and will feature six staterooms. A debut is planned for the Cannes Boat Show in 2020. avayachts.com

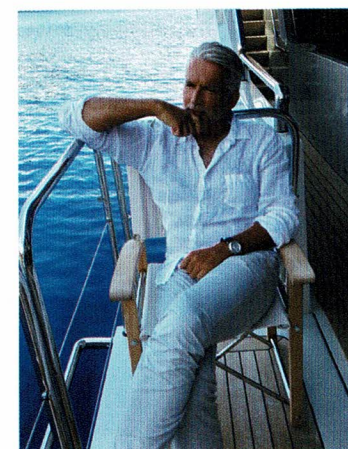
THAT'S LIFE
Oceanco says Bravo's "LIFE" design "creates a harmonious balance between weight, power, technical areas and luxury interior"

BRAVO, OCEANCO

Capping a marquee 2018 for Dutch yard Oceanco was the November launch of 358ft Project Bravo. It is the first of a new wave of yachts featuring what the yard calls its "LIFE" design - standing for lengthened, innovative, fuel-efficient and eco-friendly. Less visible than her fine, clean profile by Nuvolari Lenard but essential to her success are her naval architecture and engineering by Lateral Naval Architects. A low resistance, slender hull with fine entry and an optimized hybrid system that incorporates high-capacity batteries in a single-level engine room have allowed more space for guest areas without dramatically increasing exterior dimensions. The interior design, kept under wraps, is by Reymond Langton. oceancoyacht.com

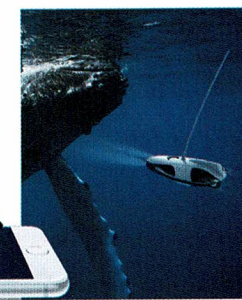
DESIGNER ON A MISSION

Dan Lenard (right), co-founder of Nuvolari Lenard, has been planning a solo journey across the Atlantic on a sailing yacht of his own design. His Vela 33 is a carbon sailboat with no electronics or instruments. If all goes as planned, he will arrive in Miami from Cadiz, Spain, in time for the boat show. His plan was to sail non-stop and guided by sight, stars and the sun, following one of Columbus's routes. "It will be just a man and the boat, like they did 5,000 years ago when they discovered the first truly sustainable vehicle - the sailboat," he says. nuvolari-lenard.com
