The yacht's design by Studio De Voogt is characterised by a familiar plumb bow and clean deck lines running from bow to stern, dressed in a light grey hull finish and crisp white superstructure. Inside, the yacht's impressive beam of 15.5 metres gives way to an airy interior by Rémi Tessier Design where Moonrise can accommodate up to 16 guests across eight staterooms. In addition, up to 32 crew can live on board in high-end quarters.



Lürssen Launches 142m Project *Opu*s

AFTER 12 MONTHS of outfitting, 142-metre Lürssen project Opus launched outside Bremen this July. The first yacht to be launched from Lürssen's upgraded floating shed facility, Opus is managed by owner representatives Moran Yacht & Ship. Built to PYC standards, Opus can accommodate up to 36 guests in 20 cabins with luxury areas spread across the yacht's six decks. "She is feature-rich with high-end amenities to delight and cater to every imaginable whim," commented a spokesperson from Moran Yacht & Ship. The sleek aft-sloping superstructure elegantly hides the yacht's spacious 9,250 GT. On bridge deck level, a helicopter landing deck aft with fold-down side platforms provide shelter for the yacht's helicopter that can be stowed away in a retractable hangar that slides neatly into the superstructure when not in use. A large sports and diving centre on the lower deck, oversized swimming pool on the main deck and a fleet of custom tenders are just some of the other features on board the vessel.
