IN JULY, CRN delivered its 62-metre superyacht *Voice*, designed inside and out by Italian studio Nuvolari Lenard. The fully-custom vessel is both the shipyard and Italy's first IMO Tier III (regarding NOx emissions) compliant superyacht. The Italian shipyard provided the naval architecture for *Voice*, which features a distinctive vertical bow, increasing the yacht's waterline length and interior volume. Design-wise, the 1288 GT displacement vessel sports a dark twotone exterior finish, as well as a signature CRN mast and is able to reach a top speed of 16 knots.

The flagship of the brand's new SeaXplorer line of adventure-ready luxury vessels was moved to Damen Yachting's Vlissingen City facility for final outfitting ready for display at the company's Private View event in September. Azure Yacht Design & Naval Architecture worked together with Damen Yachting's engineering team to build a Polar Code compliant hull which should be able to autonomously cruise all over the world. La Datcha can host two helicopters on her deck, both of which could also be stored in her internal hangar. Additionally, she carries a submersible and a fleet of tenders and toys for different environments as well as a decompression chamber for diving. Capable of accommodating 12 guests in six staterooms, La Datcha will soon join the Edmiston charter fleet.



55m Custom Admiral Yacht Geco Delivered in Greece

AT THE END of July, the custom 55.2-metre Admiral motor yacht *Geco* left the Italian Sea Group yard, making her delivery-marking maiden voyage to Flisvos Marina in Athens. Sporting an innovative layout and new-style beach club, *Geco's* exterior areas are highlighted by bar counters and a sunbathing platform with a large ultra-modern retractable swim ladder facilitating access to the sea. The upper deck layout is connected by a full-height sliding glass door and offers both indoor and outdoor lounge and dining areas. The fore helipad hangs over the hull, creating an interesting silhouette, and can be used as a special Moroccan-style lounge area. Inside, custom interior design covers *Geco's* six cabins which include both full-beam master and VIP staterooms in a style that the owner requested to create "a very social and relaxed environment."
